Essential Job Functions

- Usual medium physical requirements such as pulling, lifting, pushing in excess of 50 lbs. Rarely have physical requirements such as pulling lifting, pushing in excess of 100.lbs.
- Physical labor such as Walking, standing, bending, climbing, and kneeling for extended periods.
- Use of tools for such as, digging, prying, tightening, loosening, hammering, cleaning and cutting.
- Interacting well with customers/residents.
- Insure proper maintenance of equipment, and tools.
- Drive trucks of various sizes and weights for hauling and loading/ unloading.
- Performs required labor involved in construction and maintenance as part of a crew including, repair maintenance or replacement of pavement, service lines, main lines, fire hydrants, and pumps.
- Resolving any found or located issues with inflow such as a broken clean out.
- Assisting with or performing sewer line repairs or installs as needed.
- Assisting with or performing water line repairs or installs as needed
- Assisting with or performing Street repairs as needed.
- Assisting with City lawn care such as Mowing, weed eating, or tree removal within the Right of ways.
- Performing job functions to assist the city as a whole even outside of job scope.
- Perform scheduled maintenance and / or repairs on vehicles and large equipment.

Requirements

- High school diploma or GED equivalent.
- Valid Texas Driver's License
- Ability to perform medium level physical labor tasks for extended periods of time.
- Ability to work safely.
- Ability to communicate effectively verbally and in writing.
- Ability to carry out written or oral instructions.
