Ordinance Number 112-2009


Whereas: After proper investigation and evaluation it has been recommended that the City install an additional stop signs, making the intersection a four way stop or "all way stop" intersection.

Therefore: Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Lone Oak, Texas that:


- 1) The City Street Superintendent or his or her designee is authorized and ordered to place a stop sign on Gladys Street at the intersection of Main Street. The stop sign shall be placed on Gladys Street at the Northeast Corner of the intersection to control southbound traffic;
- 2) Proper notice shall be published prior to the erection of the stop sign pursuant to law.
- 3) The penalty for failure to observe the stop sign is the same as applied by the Laws of the State of Texas, and administered by the Judge of the Lone Oak Municipal Court or any other court with jurisdiction over any such offense.

The City Council passes this ordinance and orders the placement of this stop sign at the location set forth above.
