ORDINANCE NO: 128-2012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS EXEMPTING ITINERANT VENDORS AND TEMPORARY FOOD – SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS FROM THE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF ORDINANCE NO. 29 FOR SPECIAL CITY EVENTS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS:

Section 1. The requirements of Ordinance No. 29 that a temporary food service apply for and receive a permit and pay an applicable fee therefore is waived for temporary food-service establishments during special city events held inside the City of Lone Oak, Texas.

Section 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in force in the City of Lone Oak, Texas which conflict with the terms and provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they conflict with this ordinance, but all other provisions of said ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Should any one or more of the provisions contained in this Ordinance for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality or unenforceability shall not affect any other provisions of this Ordinance, but this Ordinance shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall remove the need for any permit for all Itinerant Vendors that would normally apply.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately from and after its passage and approval.
