

ORDINANCE NO. 43

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS  
REPEALING THE EXEMPTION FROM SALES TAX OF  
TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES IN THE CITY OF  
LONE OAK; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS

**SECTION 1.** That the exemption from sales tax granted to telecommunications services within the City under Section 321.210 of the Tax Code b and is hereby, repealed except insofar as it applies to interstate long distance telecommunication services.

**SECTION 2.** That the vote of the City Council repealing the application of the exemption shall be entered in the minutes of the meeting at which this ordinance is enacted. The City Secretary is directed to send a certified copy of this ordinance, by United States certified or registered mail, to the Comptroller of Public Accounts of the State of Texas. The repeal of the application of the exemption will take effect on the first day of the first calendar quarter occurring after the expiration of the first complete calendar quarter occurring after the date on which the Comptroller received a copy of the ordinance.

**SECTION 3.** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage as the law and charter in such cases provide.
