AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS
ESTABLISHING TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MAYOR
AND FIVE CITY ALDERMEN (COUNCIL MEMBERS).
THIS ORDINANCE TO REPLACE THE ORIGINAL WHICH
WAS DESTROYED BY FIRE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS

WHEREAS: THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR MAYOR SHALL BE FOR A TIME PERIOD OF TWO YEARS.


WHEREAS: THE TERM OF OFFICE FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS WILL BE FOR A TIME PERIOD OF TWO YEARS EACH.

WHEREAS: THE TERMS OF OFFICE FOR COUNCIL MEMBERS SHALL BE STAGGERED.


THAT IS PLACES TWO (2) AND FOUR (4) SHALL RUN CONSECUTIVE WITH THAT OF THE MAYOR.

AND PLACES ONE (1) AND THREE (3) AND FIVE (5) SHALL RUN FOR A TWO YEAR PERIOD, BEGINNING ONE YEAR FROM THE ELECTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE FIRST TWO COUNCIL MEMBERS. SO AS TO HAVE STAGGERED AND OFF SETTING TERMS.
