ORDINANCE NUMBER 54

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FOUR WAY STOP
AT THE INTERSECTION OF COLLEGE AND MCBRIDE STREETS.**

WHEREAS: There have been numerous collisions at the intersection of College Street and McBride Street and it has been determined there is potential for harm to children travelling to and from Lone Oak Middle School; and after proper investigation and evaluation it has been recommended that the City install two additional stop signs, making the intersection a four way stop or "all way stop" intersection.

THEREFORE: The City Council of the City of Lone Oak, Texas orders the following:

1. That the City Street Superintendent or his designee is authorized and ordered to place two stop signs on McBride Street at the intersection of College Street. One stop sign shall be placed on McBride Street at the Southeast corner of the intersection to control Northbound traffic; and one stop sign shall be placed on McBride Street at the Northwest corner of the intersection to control Southbound traffic.
2. Proper notice shall be published prior to the erection of the stop signs pursuant to law.
3. The penalty for failure to observe these stop signs are the same as applied by the Laws of the State of Texas, and administered by the Judge of the Lone Oak Municipal Court, or any other court with jurisdiction over any such offense.

The City Council passes this ordinance and orders the placement of these two stop signs at the location set forth above.
