

**ORDINANCE NO. 00-03-65**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS ESTABLISHING THAT THE CITY HALL IS A SMOKE-FREE ENVIRONMENT; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Lone Oak, Texas has determined a need to prohibit smoking in the City Hall building which would create a smoke-free environment, and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Lone Oak, Texas determines that such a smoke free environment is in the best interests of the citizens of the City of Lone Oak, Texas;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.** That smoking is detrimental to the maintenance of the City Hall and should be prohibited within the confines of the City Hall.

**SECTION 2.** All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of conflict only.

**SECTION 3.** That if any section, provision, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this Ordinance or application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, such holdings shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Lone Oak, Texas hereby declares it would have enacted such remaining portions, despite such invalidity.

**SECTION 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
