

ORDINANCE NO. 96

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS ESTABLISHING
POLICY TO NOT GO ON PRIVATE PROPERTY TO MAKE REPAIRS ON ANY
WATER OR SEWER LINES.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK:

SECTION 1: The City Council of the City of Lone Oak hereby adopts a policy not to go on private property to make repairs on any water or sewer lines. This is the responsibility of the residence to do these repairs. The city will only maintain city water and sewer to the owners property lines.

SECTION 2: This Ordinance shall not prevent City Employees from performing repairs or maintaining any water or sewer lines on private property that adversely impact the operation or function of City Lines and or Equipment.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force on April 14, 2003.
