There is a **three (3) minute time limit** for each speaker, unless the speaker requires the assistance of a translator, in which case the speaker is limited to six (6) minutes, in accordance with applicable law. Prior to the meeting, persons wishing to address the City Council must complete a “Speaker Form” and present it to the City Secretary prior to the meeting. When called upon, state his or her name and street address for the record, and if speaking for an organization or other group, identify the group represented. All remarks are to be addressed to the City Council as a whole and not to individual members. The presiding officer shall determine whether, or in what manner, any response will be provided.*
