RECIND NOTICE

PUBLIC NOTICE TO BOIL WATER

Due to low pressure levels, the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) has required our water system City of Lone Oak PWS # 1160006 to notify customers of the need to boil their water prior to consumption.

To ensure destruction of all harmful bacteria and other microbes, water for drinking, cooking, and making ice should be boiled and cooled prior to use. The water should be brought to a vigorous, rolling boil and then boiled for two minutes. In lieu of boiling, you may purchase bottled water or obtain water from some other suitable source.

ALL WATER SAMPLES HAVE TESTED NORMAL FOR CONSUMPTION. YOU WILL NO LONGER NEED TO BOIL YOUR WATER FOR DRINKING, COOKING AND OR MAKING ICE

When it is no longer necessary to boil the water, the water system officials will notify you that the water is safe for consumption. Instructions to discontinue boiling will be issued in the same manner as this notice.
