

ORDINANCE NO. 001B

AN ORDINANCE TO DISPENSE WITH THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL AND CONFER THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF MARSHAL UPON POLICE OFFICER OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK.

WHEREAS, Section 23.029 of the Local Government Code reads: "The governing body of any city or town operating under the general laws having less than five thousand (5,000) inhabitants according to the last preceding Federal Census, may by ordinance, dispense with the office of marshal, and at the same time by such ordinance confer the duties of said office upon a City Police Officer to be appointed as the city council shall direct".

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. THAT the office of Marshal of the City of Lone Oak, County of Hunt, Texas, is hereby dispensed with; furthermore, that the duties of said office of Marshal are hereby conferred upon a city police officer of the City of Lone Oak, Texas, to be appointed as the City Council shall direct.

SECTION 2. THAT the provisions of this ordinance shall become effective at the time this ordinance is passed and approved.
