

ORDINANCE NO. 109-2011

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING OF VEHICLES FOR STORAGE PROVIDING PENALTIES FR VIOLATIONS.

WHEREAS: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS

SECTION ONE: Overnight parking of vehicles for storage on any state, county or city roadway within the city limits is prohibited. Overnight parking of vehicles for storage is hereby defined as the storing of cars, trucks, tractors, trailers or other vehicles on roadways within the city limits in excess of two (2) hours, except temporarily disabled vehicles which are protected by flares or other approved signal devices.

SECTION TWO: PENALTIES Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).


SECTION THREE: This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval, publication or posting as required by law.
