

ORDINANCE 148-2016

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING A CASHLESS POLICY FOR THE CITY OF LONE OAK

WHEREAS, the City of Lone Oak has decided to implement a cashless policy commencing January 11, 2016.

WHEREAS, as a result of this policy, the City of Lone Oak will no longer accept any cash as a form of payment for water/sewer bills, police citations/fines, code violations or permits.

WHEREAS, No cash payments shall be made to any city department including Public Works, Municipal Court, Police Department or City Secretary.


WHEREAS, establish an ordinance that no cash be accepted by the City of Lone Oak (all departments) except for payments for public faxes, copies, notary service and donations.

WHEREAS, acceptable methods of payment include; money orders, checks, debit or credit cards. Credit and debit card transactions will have a process fee added to the face amount of the payment.

NOW THEREFORE: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS

That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
