



ORDINANCE No. 177-2021
(Amendment to Ordinance No. 109-2012)

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS PROHIBITING LONG TERM PARKING AS DEFINED IN THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 11.02 PARKING, SEC. 11.02.001 LONG TERM PARKING ON KATY STREET AND TOWN SQUARE (a) PROHIBITION; AND PROVIDING PENALTIES AND VIOLATIONS AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS: BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONE OAK, TEXAS:

SECTION ONE:

Parking of vehicles in the 100 through 400 blocks of Katy Street and the Town Square during the hours of 10:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m. is prohibited. New signage will also be posted. Parking of vehicles for storage is hereby defined as the storing of trucks, tractors, trailers, or other vehicles, except temporarily disabled vehicles which are protected by other approved signal devices.

SECTION TWO: EXEMPTIONS

To this ordinance will be for the purpose of special events within the 100 through 400 blocks of Katy Street and Town Square area of Lone Oak. In addition, this ordinance is not meant to prohibit normal parking for customers, employees, or deliveries to the businesses in the identified area.

SECTION THREE: PENALTIES

Any person violating the provisions of the Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION FOUR:

This ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and approval, publication or posting as required by law.
